NOVICE & DEVELOPMENT CLASS RULES 2024


Archery NZ has refined the rules for the Novice and Development classes, to enhance participation in competitions and tournaments by archers new to the sport. Novice archers are those new to archery, and archers in the Development Class are early in their progression of the sport.

The two class levels are designed to achieve several goals:

- Create a pathway for archers;
- Allow all archers to aspire to and meet tangible targets in their archery;
- Create a more level playing field for archers new or early in their development in the sport; and
- Assist in the development and growth of archery into a mainstream sport in New Zealand.

Rules

- 1. Archers are eligible to compete in the Novice class if they have completed an archery Beginners/Learn to shoot course or started archery within 18 months of the end of the current membership year (30 September), with automatic progression to Development Class in the following membership year.
- 2. Eligibility to compete in the Novice class is limited to one season. Novice archers will automatically progress to the Development Class in the following membership year.
- 3. Progression from Development to Open/other age classes will occur immediately after the archer has attained a single score equal to or higher than the identified Merit Score for the division (see below for scores) in competition.
- 3. Archers may choose to compete in 'higher' classes but not lower, e.g. Novice archers may choose to compete in the Development Class, or Open/other age classes directly.
- 4. Merit scores may be attained at registered minor or major tournaments.
- 5. Scores from previous seasons will be acknowledged. Therefore, if an archer has previously achieved a merit score in a given bow discipline, they will not be eligible for the development class for that discipline.
- 6. Existing full members may shoot in Novice or Development classes if they meet eligibility criteria.
- 7. An archer can be eligible for different classes for different bow divisions (Compound, Recurve, Barebow, Longbow).
 - A) An archer that competes in the Open or other age class for one bow-type division may compete in the Development class for a different division, provided they have not previously attained a score above the Merit score for that bow division.
 - B) An archer that competes in the Open or other age class for one division may not compete in the novice class for any division.
- 8. The required scores will be the same for all ages and genders within each discipline.



Archery Progression Pathway: Archers may elect to skip steps and compete in 'higher' classes.
